WHAT IS THE COMMERCIAL C&D ORDINANCE?

Construction and demolition (C&D) debris makes up 33% of all landfilled waste in Nashville, reducing regional landfill capacity. Based on peer research, evaluation of local costs and benefits, and state materials management goals, Metro has outlined a proposed ordinance phasing in requirements to reduce C&D waste from commercial projects.
