**SIGNATORY AUTHORITY FOR CITY MANAGER TO SIGN DOCUMENTS FOR TDEC  
NON-COMPETITIVE GRANT - DWR-ARP NON-COLLABORATIVE STATE WATER  
INFRASTRUCTURE GRANTS (SWIG) PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2021, the President of the United States signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to provide continued relief from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) announced the application process is open for non-competitive grants from the federal American Rescue Plan (ARP), which TDEC is partially administering for the State of Tennessee; and

**WHEREAS**, The funds are targeted for improving Stormwater infrastructure in communities throughout Tennessee; and


