**RESOLUTION 2022-R-04**

**TDEC NON-COMPETITIVE GRANT - DWR-ARP NON-COLLABORATIVE STATE WATER INFRASTRUCTURE GRANTS (SWIG) PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2021, the President of the United States signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to provide continued relief from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) announced the application process is open for non-competitive grants from the federal American Rescue Plan (ARP), which TDEC is partially administering for the State of Tennessee; and

**WHEREAS**, The funds are targeted for improving stormwater improvements and infrastructure in communities throughout Tennessee; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oak Hill has been notified by the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation that funding in the amount of \$738,569.19 has been made available to the City of Oak Hill in the form of a non-competitive grant program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissions will accept grant funds once approved and granted by TDEC to be added to the budget for the purpose of stormwater improvements and infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, this grant program requires co-funding from the City of Oak Hill in the amount of \$258,499.21, and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissions will ensure these grant funds will be allocated to provide public stormwater improvements and infrastructure within the City of Oak Hill; and

**NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED** by the City of Oak Hill Board of Commissioners that the allocation of the funding for these government services is hereby authorized as outlined in this Resolution.
