A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DAVIDSON COUNTY ELECTION COMMISSION TO HOLD A GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF OAK HILL, TENNESSEE IN 2022

WHEREAS, Section 6-20-102 of the Charter for the City of Oak Hill Tennessee provides for a general city election on the first Tuesday in August; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Board of Commissioners are four years and elected on a staggered basis; and

WHEREAS, the terms of office for the commissioner seats held by John DeLuca, Dale Grimes, and Joy O'Dell, expire in 2022.


