

RESOLUTION 22-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, TENNESSEE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO DISPOSE OF THE PROPERTY THAT HAS BEEN DEEMED SURPLUS, OUT OF SERVICE, SEIZED OR ABANDONED.

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Hill (The City) is in possession of property that is no longer in service and/or no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of The City to dispose of surplus, out of service, seized or abandoned property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Oak Hill Board of Commissioners that:

Section 1: The following items are hereby declared surplus, out of service, seized or abandoned property:

- **Two (2) Each Speed Aware, 9" Radar Speed Signs/White 20W**

Section 2: The City Manager may dispose of the property in a manner deemed appropriate. As a general rule, items of value shall be offered to the public for sale to the highest bidder.

Section 3: All money received from the sale of said property shall be deposited in the appropriate accounting fund.

Section 4: All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict here within be, and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage as provided by law.
